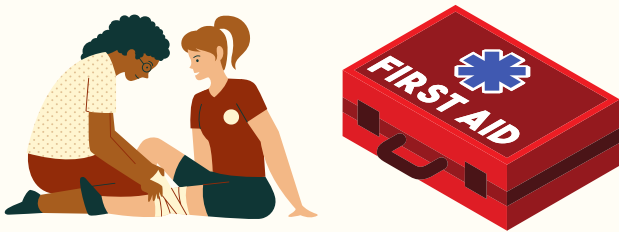

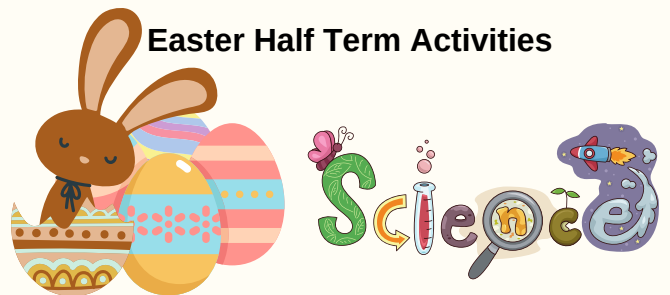
## SURGERY: Speak with Patricia Aihie

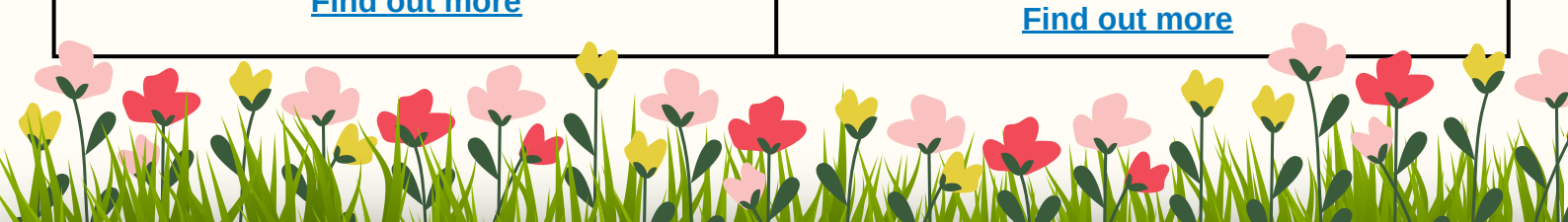
## Easter Half Term Activities

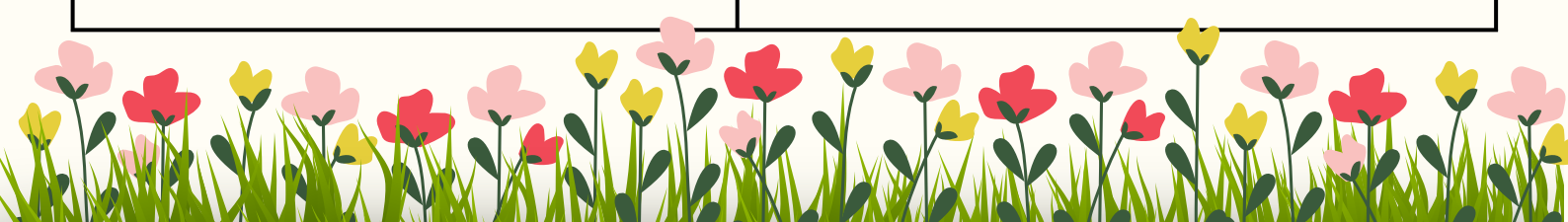

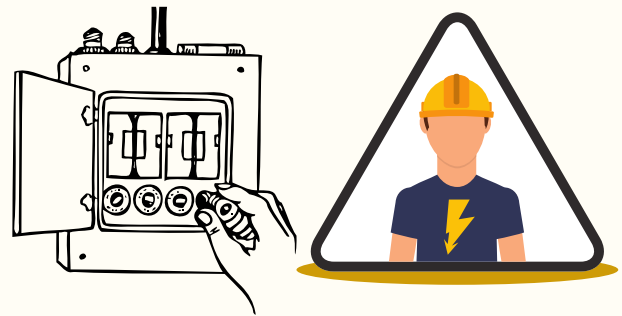
## Education and Employment Grant
