Terms and conditions

- 3. All attendees must live in an SW9 Community Housing property.

- 4. Each household is eligible to attend only one coach trip.
- 5. Age restrictions apply to certain activities.
- 6. When allocating space on activities the decision of SW9 Community Housing is final.
