Parking On The

Stockwell Park Estate

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In February 2025, SW9 undertook a major overview of changes to the parking scheme for the Stockwell Park and Robsart Village Estates. This leaflet contains updated information and acts as a guide on safe and secure parking actions for you and your visitors.

PCNs issued before 6.00pm (Monday-Friday)

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Vehicles causing contraventions or those which are parked illegally will be issued a PCN Notice on the windscreen, between the hours of 7.00am and 6.00pm.

PCNs issued after 6.00pm (Monday-Friday)

Vehicles causing contraventions or those which are parked illegally will receive a Notice to Keeper PCN. This will be notified in letter format through the post rather than a physical PCN on the windscreen after 6.00pm, for safety reasons.

What if someone parks in your allocated parking bay

If you rent or have paid outright for an allocated vehicle bay and you find someone parking in your bay, please take down the registration number and description of the vehicle, take a photo where possible, and contact Bridge Pam either by telephone on **020 3763 1575** or via email on info@bridgepam.com.

Please advise Bridge Pam that due to the contravention you will need to park in a visitors bay and provide your vehicle information to avoid being ticketed. This also applies if you have received a ticket and you wish to have it cancelled.

Please retain your email and/or obtain a reference number from Bridge Pam for any possible challenges. Please remember to keep your permit displayed if you need to park in a visitors bay in order for the warden to check that your bay has been obstructed and issue a contravention ticket quicker.

237, 239, 241, 243 Brixton Road parking

There is a limited number of parking bays available at these blocks (six) and are for the use for tenants who reside at these addresses - on a first come, first serve basis. Each household is only allowed 1 permit per household, and vehicles must be registered to these blocks. We would recommend residents of these blocks to approach Lambeth for local parking permits for the nearby area, due to the lack of bays on the estate.

Vehicles without license plates displayed

We've received reports that a number of vehicles on the estate are being parked without license plates. Please note that vehicles parked on the estate must be insured, road worthy and display a vehicle registration at all times.

If you have a car cover, your vehicle registration must still be displayed. Alternative signage on your car cover to display the registration is currently acceptable.

Failure to adhere to the above may lead to us reporting your vehicle to the DVLA and the local police as an abandoned vehicle.

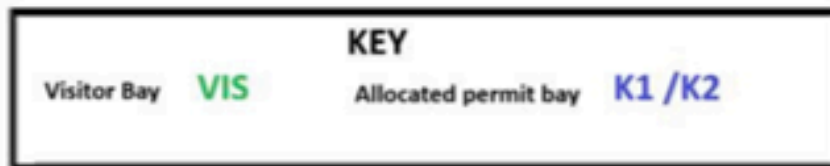

Knowle Close

There are two Allocated permit bays (K1 & K2) on the corner of Knowle Close. The other 2 unmarked bays on the left of them are for visitors. If anyone parks in bay K1 or K2 which are not the allocated vehicles for these bays, they will be issued a PCN.



Street parking for Wynnans Walk & Wynne Road

Bay outlines are coming to both streets in the coming weeks for clearer parking on both of these streets. Please be reminded street permits can park on any of the street parking bays of either of these two streets however it is first come first serve. This can **only** apply to residents with vehicles registered to an address on the Stockwell Park Estate.

Moat Place

There is **no longer** street parking on Moat Place. There are now only allocated bays and street permits will no longer be available to use in any of these bays. Please use street permits on Wynnans Walk or Wynne Road only.

Disabled bays

Earlier in the year we advised that Blue Badge users could be assigned an allocated disabled bay in the undercroft for free. However, due to the large number of Blue Badge users and limited disabled bays, we could only accommodate the initial Blue Badge with evidence of additional mobility issues on a first come first serve basis. To accommodate other Blue Badge users on the estate, we have offered a **£2.50 weekly discount** for any bay they rent on the estate.

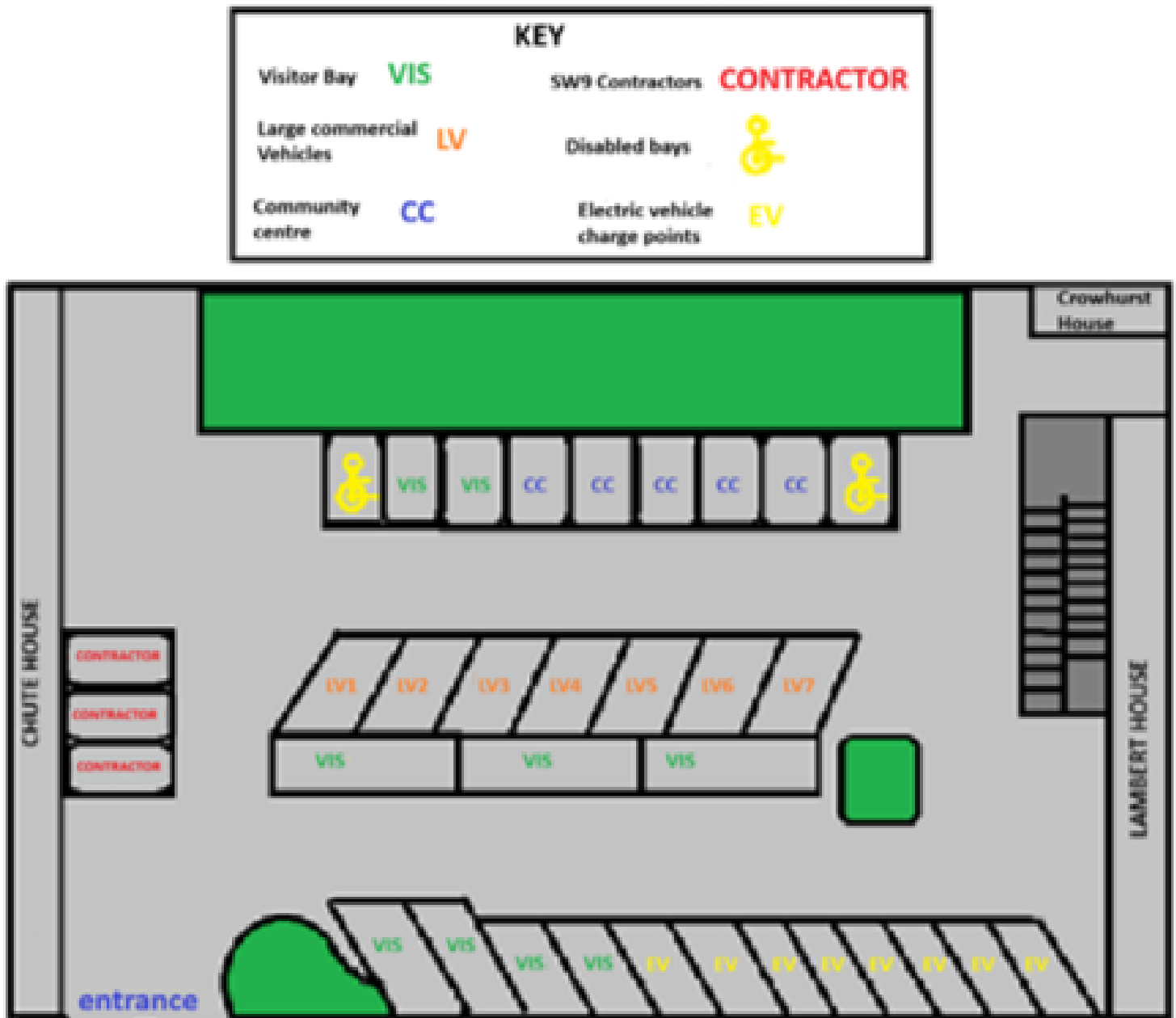
Update on Visitor Parking in The Square

The Square Visitors parking is now open; however, only to users with physical visitors permits. The map on the following page outlines the area.

There are:

- 3 contractor bays located by the wall of Chute House (These become visitors bays outside of contractor hours 8am -8pm Monday to Friday).
- 7 Large Commercial vehicle bays labeled as LV1- LV7 – Allocated permit parking only.
- 5 parking bays for the Community Centre (These become visitors bays outside of operating hours of 8am -6pm Monday to Friday)
- 2 disabled bays – Non allocated - for use any Blue Badge user.
- 9 Visitors bays (17 when contractor bays and Community Centre bays turn to visitors bays).
- 6 electric charge point bays

Visitors Parking Locations

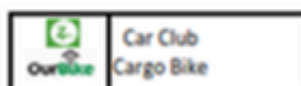
There are no longer visitors parking bays in front of Cumnor House. These are now EV charging bays.

There are now an additional 9 at daytime and 17 at night visitors bays in The Square.

There are an additional 2 visitors bays on Knowle Close.
