Terms and conditions

- 1. The primary attendee must be the named tenant/leaseholder.
- 2. Attendees under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3. All attendees must live in a property managed by SW9 Community Housing.
- 4. In case of oversubscription, each household is eligible to attend only one coach trip.
- 5. When allocating space on activities, the decision of SW9 Community Housing is final.
